Information requested in relation to FOI/034/20 response:

In regards the alleged inappropriate search and sexual assault then I would request a confirmation or denial of if the accused male in each case was found guilty of the accuser's allegation within a criminal court of law by jury trial and have not had there conviction overturned on a finding of innocence by a jury court of appeal and if so confirmed the case then please disclose all held data in regards each incident with the victim's name redacted and convicted male staff members details fully disclosed. If any of the accused were not tried, found not-proven, not guilty in a criminal court by jury trial or had their initial conviction overturned by a jury appeal court on a finding of innocence then I would not request such data or details of the accused disclosed.

Response:

We have rechecked our complaints files and found no information beyond that which we have already provided. Telephone calls to the Director of Security are not logged and therefore we have no records to search regarding any telephone calls from Police Scotland.

We have conducted a search on the local files held by The Director of Security based on the individual's name that advised our complaint Team that they were going to make a complaint and have found no information relating the request FOI/034/20 or the questions above.

We give notice under section 17 of FOISA that we do not hold the information you are seeking.
