Advice and Guidance

The State Hospital has searched our Human Resources files, Complaints files and Person Centred Improvement files as well as our incident recording system in relation to questions A, B & C. If an incident of racism, sectarianism or ableism has been recorded, these areas are where this information would be held.

We have applied exemption FOISA Section 38(1)(b) (Personal information) to a small amount of information. This is because a motivated individual would be able to identify a patient from the information directly or if linked to other information available to them.

Patients detained at The State Hospital are vulnerable individuals and have the same expectation of confidentiality and privacy from The State Hospital as all patients of NHS Scotland have from those treating them. They have no expectation that their personal information will be published and to do so would be in contravention of the 1st data protection principle (UK GDPR Article 5(1)(a)- "Personal data shall be processed lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner...").
