Please provide a list of all gender options you list on patient forms.

Response:

The State Hospital primarily uses electronic patient records (EPR) to record patient information. Although there are over 140 digital forms used within the systems, as digital systems link recorded pieces of information together, these systems only required gender to be populated once. Typically this will be from the form ADM1.

The gender options available in;

- Our EPR are; Male, Female, Not Specified & Unknown.
- The government provided ADM1, CTO1, CO1, CT03a, CTO4a, CTO5, REV5. DET1, DET2 & HD1 forms (https://www.gov.scot/publications/mental-health-law-forms/) are; Male, Female, Prefer not to say & Not Listed (with a free text box) and CO5 is Male & Female.
- Our Smoking Cessation Assessment Form and Glasgow Antipsychotic Side-effect Scale Form are; Male & Female.
- Our Pharmacy E-Care Plan is a free text box.
